This 10 week program allows citizens to learn and experience the inner world of law enforcement, and a firsthand look at the daily operations of the Westerly Police Department.

The training will consist of classroom instruction, demonstrations, tours, as well as hands-on practical applications. Instructors will be members of the Westerly Police Department to include patrol officers, supervisors, and administrators. Some of the topics to be offered include:

**WHEN?** The 10 week academy will run from Nov. 2, 2017-Jan. 11, 2018. Classes will be from 6:30 – 8:30 PM on Thursday evenings.
